Hi Todd,

It's been another tough year when it comes to gun violence in the city. While we've made progress in reducing the number of shootings year-over-year and over the past three years, it's not enough. And unfortunately, the state legislature has not just shown disinterest in helping combat gun violence, but instead it's been outright hostile towards the City as we've attempted to take legislative action.

I have already reached out to CPD and Councilmember Johnson about CPD presenting their 2024 data at Public Safety in early February. In addition, the City will soon share its gun violence prevention blueprint, which is the culmination of multiple years of community engagement paired with data analysis and national best practices. I hope you will keep an eye out for that and the presentation coming soon.
